#### Men's Basketball

Averaging a double-double and leading St. Scholastica to a pair of conference wins has earned senior guard William Maupins this week's UMAC men's basketball player of the week award. Maupins (Rosemount, MN) scored 44 points in the two games (22 ppg) and pulled down 26 rebounds (13 rpg). In Friday's win over Minnesota-Morris he had 29 points and 15 boards and had 15 points and 11 rebounds against Presentation College.

#### Women's Basketball

Presentation College junior guard Callie Antonsen is this week's UMAC women's basketball player of the week. Antonsen (Platte, SD) led the Saints to a 62-52 win at St. Scholastica Saturday in Duluth with a 43 point performance. She was 11-of-18 (61 %) from the field including 3-of-4 from behind the arc. And she was 18-19 from the free-throw line. For the week, she tallied 56 points (28 ppg) on 14-of-30 (46%) from the field and hauled in 19 rebounds to go along with six steals and six assists.

#### Women's Indoor Track & Field

University of Minnesota-Morris senior Ashley Wintheiser is this week's Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC) women's track and field athlete of the week. Competing at the NDSU Bison Classic last weekend, Wintheiser(Lino Lakes, MN) placed 8th in the weight throw at 44-4 1/2. The meet featured only one other Division III school with a couple of Division I and NAIA teams.

#### Men's Indoor Track & Field

This week's Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC) men's track and field athlete of the week is Patrick O'Connor of the University of Minnesota-Morris. O'Connor (Fr. Ham Lake, MN) had a PR in the 60 meter Hurdles with 9.38, .02 seconds off the school record at the Bison Classic at NDSU last weekend.
