Men's Basketball

St. Scholastica senior guard Derek Johnson has been named this week's UMAC men's basketball player of the week. Johnson (St. Louis Park, MN) was key in the saints winning the UMAC men's basketball post-season tournament over the weekend. In three games he scored 57 points (19.0 ppg), including 24 in the 92-90 overtime win over Northwestern in the championship game. He was 18-of-42 (42.8%) from the floor and connected on 39 percent (14-36) from three-point range. Johnson was also named the post-season tournament MVP.

Women's Basketball

Presentation College junior guard Callie Antonsen has been named this week's UMAC women's basketball player of the week. Antonsen (Platte, SD) led the Saints to the regular season and post-season titles last week. In three games Antonsen tallied 88 points (29.3 ppg), including 34 against Minnesota-Morris in the game Tuesday that determined the regular season championship and then 32 in the post-season tournament title game. She was 30-of-67 (44.7%) from the field and shot 83 percent (25-30) from the free-throw line in the three games. It is the second straight POW award and fourth overall this season for Antonsen.

Women's Indoor Track & Field

University of Minnesota-Morris freshman Megan Croatt has been selected the UMAC women's track and field athlete of the week. Croatt (Ortonville, MN) took third in the 55 meter dash at the Carleton meet last weekend with a time of 7.59. She also set a new UMM school record in the pole-vault at 7-8 1/2. It is the second time this season Croatt has earned the athlete of the week award.

Men's Indoor Track & Field

This week's Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC) men's track and field athlete of the week is Anders Carlson of the University of Minnesota-Morris. Carlson (Sr. Maple Plain, MN) placed third in the high jump at the Carleton indoor meet last Friday at 5-9 1/4, which is a personal record. In the long jump Carlson was fifth at 18-11, also a new PR.

Women's Tennis

This week's Upper Midwest Athletic Conference (UMAC) women's tennis player of the week is Amy Green of Northwestern College. Green (Fr. Cedar Falls, IA) defeated Rikki Peach of the College of St. Catherine's 7-5, 5-7, 10-4 at the # 4 singles position last week.
