University of Minnesota-Morris wide receiver Ryan Stoick is the UMAC North Division offensive player of the week. Stoick (Jr. Morris, MN) caught five passes for 45 yards in the Cougars win over Trinity. Four of those receptions were for touch downs, setting a UMM record for touchdown catches in a game

#### Football North Division Defensive

This weeks North Division defensive player of the week winner is McYoung Yang (Westfield, IN) of Crown College. Young had 10 tackles, seven solo and three assisted in the Storm's win at Martin Luther. He also had one interception in helping to hold MLC to just seven points

#### Football North Division Special Teams

Northwestern College punter Josh Peterson (Sr. Fairmont, MN) has earned the UMAC North Division special teams player of the week honors. Peterson had seven punts for 248 yards (35.4/punt) and a long of 43. He had five punts inside the 20 and stuck two inside the 10 yard line

#### Football South Division Offensive

With 159 yards rushing on 24 carries in Rockfords win over Maranatha Baptist, junior runing back John Feehan (Loves Park, IL) is this week's UMAC South Division offensive player of the week. Feehan averaged 6.6 yards per carry and scored once in the ball game.

Wicks (Jr. Rockton, IL) had four punt returns for 53 yards, a long of 29 and one kick return for 59 yards. #### Men's Soccer Defensive

Justin O'Connor (Fr. Ham Lake, MN) of the University of Minnesota-Morris has been named this week's UMAC men's soccer defensive player of the week. O'Connor helped anchor the Cougar defense as UMM picked up two UMAC road wins as the Cougars allowed just two goals in the two games, a 2-1 win at Martin Luther and a 2-1 win at Bethany Lutheran

#### Men's Soccer Offensive

With two game winning goals, Patrick O'Connor (Fr. Ham Lake, MN) helped lead Minnesota-Morris to two key UMAC road wins and has received this week's UMAC men's soccer defensive player of the week honors. In the Cougars two wins, 2-1 over Martin Luther and 2-1 over Bethany Lutheran. O'Connor recorded the two game winning goals along with two assists.
