Senior goalkeeper Evan Ormand of Presentation College is this weeks UMAC men's soccer defensive player of the week. The senior from Aberdeen stopped all 12 shots on goal in the Saints 0-0 (2ot) game against York College on Sunday. For the season he has stopped 14 of 15 shots for a .941 save pct.

Women's Soccer Offensive

Nicole Seviola (Circle Pines, MN) of Northwestern College was named as the UMAC women's soccer offensive player of the week. A sophomore forward, Nicole set a new school record for points in a game with 11 in the Eagles win over North Central University last week. She also tied a school record for assists in a game with three and tied her own mark for goals in a game with four.

Volleyball Hitter

Recording 57 kills in helping Presentation College to three wins in four matches at the Crown College Tournament over the weekend, earned Heidi Meier (So. OH. Marshall, MN) the UMAC volleyball hitter of the week honors. She had 20 kills against Faith Baptist and North Central University. Meier also added 60 digs to go along with 13 ace serves.

Volleyball Setter

Brie McRae (Fr. S. Duluth, MN) of Northland College is this weeks UMAC setter of the week. In four matches for the Lumberjills at the Augsburg Tournament, she had 110 assists (7.86/gm), 32 in the Northland match against Wisconsin Lutheran and was the only freshman named to the 10 member all-tournament team. Volleyball Defensive Specialist

St. Scholastica's Diana Moody (Jr. Lib. Hibbing, MN) has earned the UMAC defensive specialist of the week honors. Moody recorded 157 digs in helping to lead the Saints to three win in five matches. She had 40 digs in the win over St. Mary's and only nine errors
