

**Academic Year Saturday Session Policies**

**Reminder:** Participants serve as representatives of the UB program and The College of St. Scholastica. This should be reflected in their words and actions.

**All policies are effective the moment you arrive on the CSS campus.**

Please be aware that rules 1 through 4 are the “major” rules for the UB program and an infraction of rules 1 – 4 may result in immediate dismissal from the UB program. In other words, we have a “zero tolerance” policy for these first four rules. Parents will be immediately contacted if a student breaks any of the first 4 rules. Parents will then be held responsible for the return transportation of their child (i.e. the student will not be allowed to ride the bus home from CSS or any off-campus location).

- 1. Sexual activity or references to sexually explicit material will not be permitted during the program.**
- 2. The use or possession of drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, or tobacco will not be tolerated.**
- 3. No fighting, physical abuse, harassment, or stealing.**
- 4. The possession of firearms or other weapons on campus is grounds for immediate dismissal from the UB program.**
5. Appropriate language is expected. Swearing and vulgarity will not be tolerated.
6. Participants are only allowed in designated areas.
7. Vehicles are allowed on campus. Participants must park in designated lots.
8. Cell phones and personal stereos (with or without earphones), video games, MP3 players, Game Boys, etc. are not to be worn or played at any time during the Saturday Session.
9. The UB program is not responsible for any personal items that are lost or stolen during the course of the program.

**Summer Attendance Policy**

Attendance is expected to all summer sessions. Students must attend the first summer session immediately following their admission into the UB program.

**Bridge Attendance Policy**

In order to participate in the Bridge program, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Graduate from high school prior to starting the Bridge program.
2. Be accepted and intend to go to college the fall immediately following the program (students enlisting in the military who will be taking off Fall Semester to do Basic Training will not be allowed to participate in Bridge).
3. Complete all necessary forms for enrollment into PSE, as well as make the required deposits for housing and enrollment **by May 15<sup>th</sup>**.

I recognize and understand that failure to meet any one of these requirements could result in being released from the Upward Bound Program at any given time.
