### Football North Division Offensive

Versus Blackburn, quarterback Matt Bremer rushed 17 times for 100 yards and four touchdowns. Bremer was also 18-of-30 passing for 287 yards and two touchdowns, yielding no interceptions.

### Football North Division Defensive

In Saturday's game against Trinity, Ben Olson notched two first half interceptions in Martin Luther's victory, including two passes defended and four tackles in one half of play. On the season, Olson leads the team with three interceptions and six passes defended.

### Football North Division Special Teams

Caleb Free had five punts for a 43.8 yard average in Martin Luther's game against Trinity, including a long of 48 and one punt inside the 20 yard line.

### Football South Division Offensive

Caleb Rader had 25 carries for 163 yards and three touchdowns in Maranatha's 20-14 win over Principia on Saturday. Rader's longest run of the day was 63 yards, and he averaged 6.5 yards per carry. For 2007, Rader has 278 yards and five touchdowns.

### Football South Division Defensive

Tom Marcum made his way into every kind of defensive play for Rockford on Saturday, recording seven tackles, a fumble recovery, an interception and a pass break-up in the Regents' 36-14 win over Westminster.

### Football South Division Special Teams

Rockford's Chris Kunde was 4-for-4 in PATs with three punts for an average of 39.7 yards per punt. Kunde is 15-for-20 on PAT attempts this season and 1-for-2 on field goal attempts.

### Men's Soccer Offensive

In Bethany Lutheran's three games last week, Richard Rowell scored five goals, including three scores against Martin Luther. Rowell also recorded three assists throughout the week.

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARDS

#### Men's Soccer Defensive

Joseph Romero led Presentation College to a UMAC victory this weekend with his efforts in goal in an overtime contest Friday afternoon against Northwestern. During play, Romero stopped six of the seven shots he faced during 95 minutes of action in a 2-1 overtime victory. Romero is 4-3 on the season with 39 saves and a 1.57 GAA.

#### Women's Soccer Offensive

Kyrie Jorgenson scored five goals in Northwestern's 8-0 win over Presentation on Saturday, setting a new school record for goals in a game. As a freshman, Jorgenson leads the Eagles with nine goals and four assists in 2007.

#### Women's Soccer Defensive

St. Scholastica's Cortney McKenzie is the leader of a Saints defense that allowed two shots on goal and recorded three shutouts in three games last week. To add to her defensive stats, she added her first collegiate goal against Martin Luther and had two assists during the week.

#### Volleyball Hitter

St. Scholastica's Shawna Varichak recorded 78 kills over the weekend posting wins against Morris, Presentation, Martin Luther and a very tight 5-game loss to Bethany Lutheran (30-32, 29-31, 30-19, 31-29, 8-15). She broke her own match-high kill record this week (27) after setting the record last weekend against New York University (26). She served at a .971% missing only 2 serves out of 71 total attempts. She also had 41 digs and 7 blocks.

#### Volleyball Setter

In four matches this weekend at the UMAC rotational, Joelle Shouts had 161 total set assists, averaging 40.25 per match. She also went 54-for-54 serving. Bethany plays a 5-1 and Joelle really hustled all weekend to lead her team to a 2-2 finish in two days.

#### Volleyball Defensive Specialist

Diana Moody had a match-high 40 digs in a tight loss to Bethany Lutheran (30-32, 29-31, 30-19, 31-29, 8-15) on Saturday. She posted another 62 digs in St. Scholastica's three other wins over Morris, Presentation and Martin Luther this weekend at the UMAC crossover. Moody had a total of eight reception errors in 86 attempts for a .907 service reception percentage. She recorded five service aces with one error in 53 attempts for a .981 serving percentage.
