

Fast Track Application Process: Master of Science in Exercise Physiology

Who is eligible: The College of St. Scholastica's seniors enrolled in the

undergraduate Exercise Physiology program who, at the time of application, have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher.

Why: Current enrolled seniors can bypass aspects of the graduate

application process. Faster. Easier. Less Hassle. Since the faculty of the program have already interacted with the students, they are aware of their ability to be successful in the graduate program.

What it entails:

- Applications must be received by February 15. This gives both the
 Office of Graduate Admissions and the EXP department an idea of
 what the incoming class will look like. Students who submit the
 application after February 15 would have to go through the entire
 application process.
- Applicants must have an overall cumulative GPA of 2.8 at the time
 of application and must be on track to graduate. Verification will be
 made to ensure that they are on track to graduate. Students who do
 not have the overall GPA of 2.8 at the time of application will be
 required to complete the entire application process.
- Applicants will be exempt from writing the essay and submitting the two graduate recommendations.
- If an applicant is accepted, it would be on a provisional basis until conferral of the bachelor's degree.
- Note: Meeting minimal entrance requirements does not necessarily guarantee admission.
