Once you click on an eBook's title, you will see a description. Below the description, you can see how many concurrent or simultaneous users can be looking at this eBook at the same time. That is helpful information to know if you are going to have an entire class use this eBook.

Links to the left allow you to either view the eBook's PDF full text within the database or to *Download* so you can view it offline.

It is recommended to just view the PDF because if someone downloads it, that will make it unavailable for everyone else for up to seven days. This is important to note if an entire class is going to be using this eBook.

To download an eBook, you must first create an EBSCO account. See the end of this document for more information on how to do that.

Links to the right allow you to add this to a folder, cite it, or get the permalink.



Permalinks are helpful because they allow you to share a link to this eBook with anyone in the CSS community. Once you click on *Permalink*, you will get a long URL or web address, which begins with https://akin.css.edu/login... This is a special web address, which includes the College's secure proxy server.

When you share this link, whoever clicks on it will be prompted to log in with their CSS username and password in order to view this eBook. Since the Library has purchased access to this eBook, we have a legally obtained copy of it, which can be shared with our community.



Click on the pull-down menu for *Table of Contents* near the bottom of the screen or else the link for *PDF Full Text* in the left column to view the chapter titles to navigate more easily through the eBook.

Once you click on the *PDF Full Text* link, you can select a section you would like to save, email, or print by clicking on those options in the top toolbar.
