



Finding the Permalink in ProQuest Databases

Let the Library help you add content to your courses without the worry of copyright! One way to do this is to add links to your courses. It is strongly recommended that you add the permalink to your courses. This will ensure that you are adding content to your courses that is free of copyright issues.




To locate the permalink in ProQuest databases, follow these steps:

1. Locate the article that you want in one of the ProQuest databases.
2. Once you find the article you want, click on the title of the article, which will open up the article.



5. Highlight the Document URL. Then copy and paste the permalink anywhere you want! It is especially useful in webpages, Blackboard courses, PowerPoints, and other electronic resources.

Note: When clicking on the article link, students will need to login with their network username and password (the same username and password used to access Cor, Blackboard, or CSS email).
