This database searches the titles of articles and the indexes of print and electronic reference books the Library has, such as almanacs, dictionaries, and specialized encyclopedias.

****Note:** The Library has more reference books on your topic that are not in Reference Universe, so please ask the Librarians as well when wanting to find reference books.

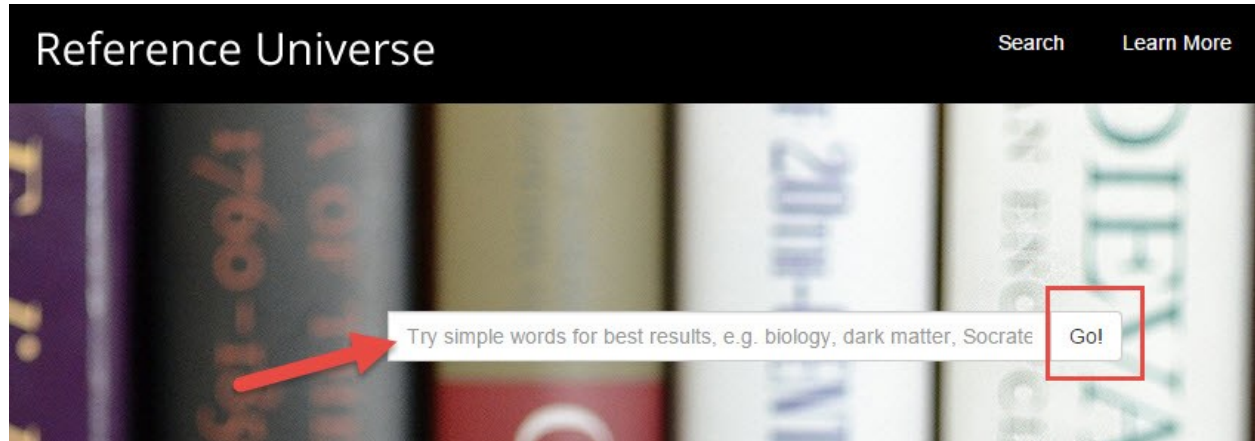

Enter your topic in the box after *Keywords* and click on *search now*.



Results Page

Click on *E-books* or *Print* to limit to encyclopedias that are either full-text online or in print in the Library.

Click on a Subject Heading to limit to just those encyclopedias on that topic.

Click on the *Article Titles* or *Index Entries* to see the individual article titles and page numbers.

If it says *eBook* in blue, then when you click on the *Article Titles* or the *Index Entries*, you will get links to the full text of the encyclopedia's articles.

Check the boxes to the right of the screen for encyclopedias you are interested in and then you can email them to yourself or download them to EndNote by clicking on those boxes at the top of your results list.

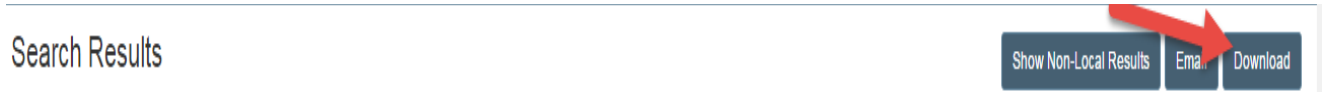

Exporting Citations to EndNote

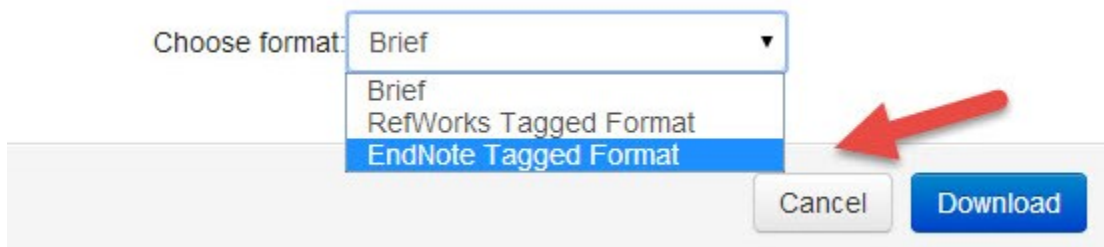

Click on the box to the right of encyclopedias you wish to export.

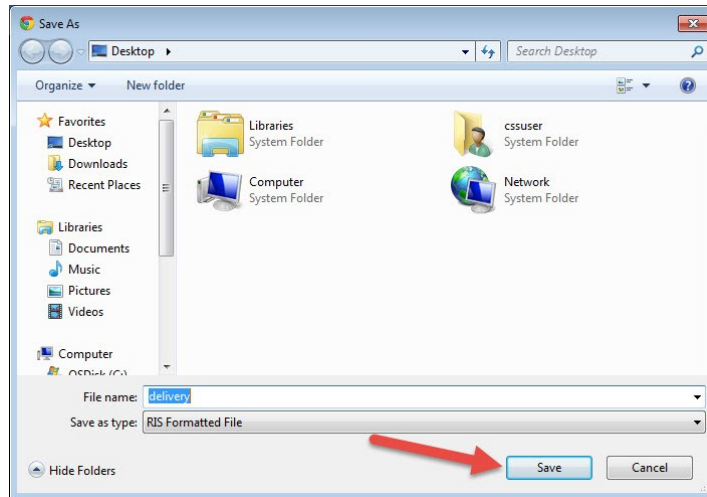
Click on the Download button to the right at the top of the screen.



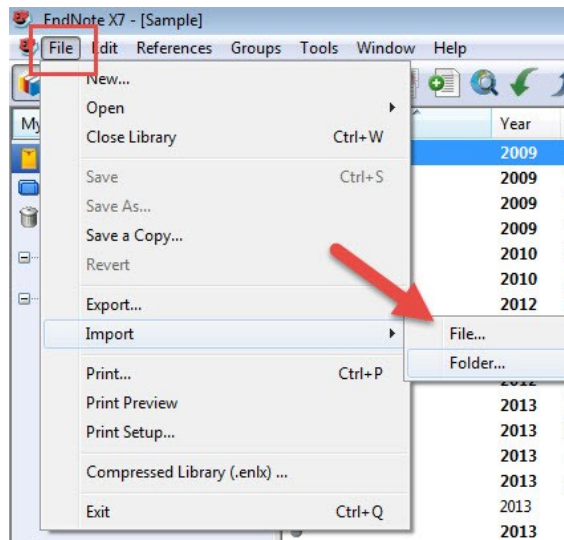
Click on *EndNote Tagged Format* and then click on the *Download* button.



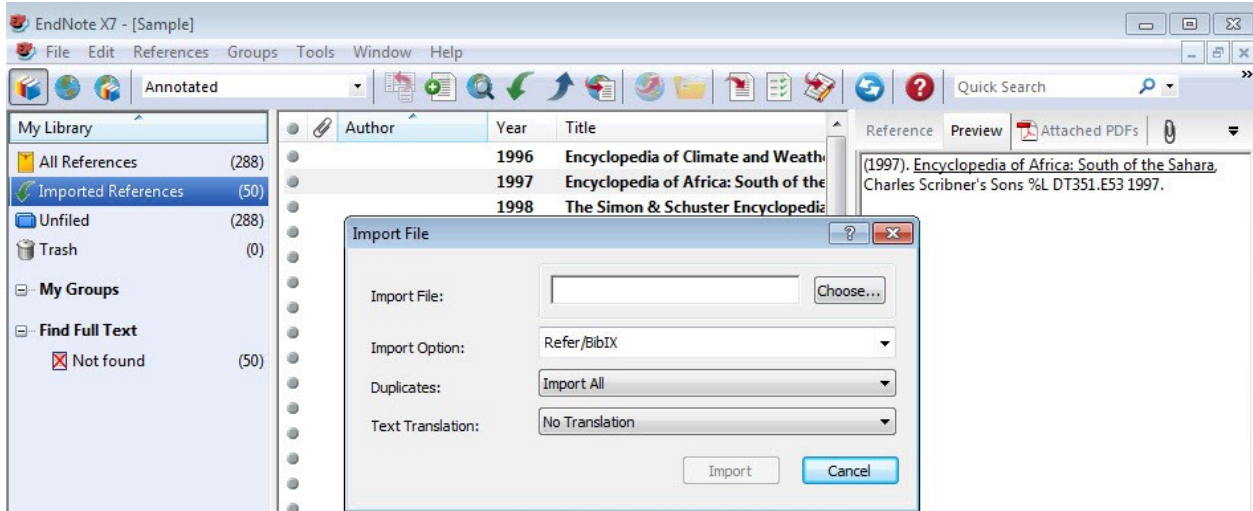
Click on *Save* where you wish the file to be saved.



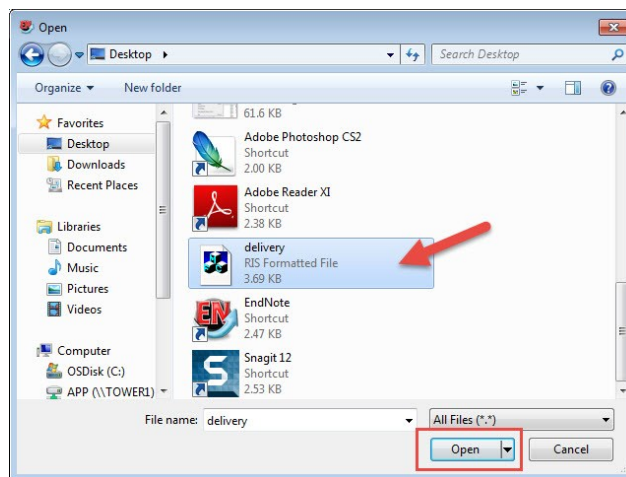
Open the EndNote library you wish to add the citation to and in the *File* tool bar option, select *Import* and *File...*



Select the *Import* Option and click on *Refer/BibIX*.



Click on *Choose...* to select the file you just saved and click on *Open*.



Your citations will now automatically be added to your EndNote library.
